Youth Olympic Games 2018 – European Qualification Process

Dear Sir or Madam,

Following the UEFA Circular Letter of 2nd June 2017 regarding the European qualification process to the Youth Olympics 2018, we are pleased to provide you with a further information.

Participation and hosting

With regards to the entry process for the boys' national team qualification, 21 National Associations have been applying for the 16 slots available. Please hereafter find the 16 teams that are eligible to participate to the four mini-tournaments which will be taking place from 1 to 4 November 2017 (according to the coefficient ranking), with the hosts in bold:

Boys' Competition:

Portugal	Czech Republic

Kazakhstan	Belgium

For the girls' national team qualification, 12 National Associations have been applying for the 8 slots available. The 8 eligible teams are listed below (in the coefficient rankings order), with the hosts in bold. The two mini-tournaments will be played simultaneously with the boys' ones from 1 to 4 November 2017.

Seeding and draw

The UEFA Administration will proceed to the draw and determine the composition of the mini-tournaments. The results will be sent by e-mail to all participating associations together with a footage of the draw and will be published on www.uefa.com.

For the boys' competition, the top four teams in the coefficient rankings will be seeded (position 1) and the rest will be then drawn according to their coefficient rankings (from position 2 to 4).

For the girls' competition, the same system will apply, with the top two teams in the coefficient rankings to be seeded.


Competition guidelines
